INTERAGENCY COOPERATION

AUTHORITY: NRS 209.131

RESPONSIBILITY

All correctional administrators are responsible to coordinate planning and consultation with community related groups in order to enhance the operations of the Department (4-4005).

126.01 INTERAGENCY COOPERATION

1. Special efforts should be made to consult with but not limited to:
 - A. Law enforcement agencies
 - B. Officers of the court
 - C. Community leaders
 - D. Colleges and universities
 - E. Community based agencies
2. NDOC Administrators, Associate Wardens, and Division Heads should encourage staff to participate in local, regional, and national justice associations.
3. NDOC administrators will be available to assist other agencies or related organizations for the purpose of ensuring the integration of NDOC into the overall criminal justice system.
4. Memorandums of Understanding (MOU) may be initiated with other agencies to clarify an agency's responsibility in a cooperative agreement.

APPLICABILITY


1. This AR requires an Operational Procedure (OP) for each institution/facility.
