Offenders on Parole - NRS 209.4475

Offenders on parole or released on parole after January 1, 2004 are credited with 20 days (this amount has been doubled) for good time if the offender is current with paying his fees and restitution. The parolee can receive 10 days for work time as well.

Parolees who were placed on parole before July 1, 2007 will receive credits allowed under the revised NRS 209.4465 retroactively for one year.

What it means:

All parolees will receive additional stat time for each day they serve while current on fees and restitution, beginning July 1, 2007.

Parolees who were placed on parole before July 1, 2007 will receive stat time credits against their maximum sentence going back up to one year.

Parolees who are current on fees and restitution will expire their parole in less time.

This applies equally to inmates released on parole and inmates on "institutional" parole.
