ELEMENTS OF NON-DEADLY FORCE

<p>Ability or Apparent Ability</p> <p>Does the violator possess the ability or the apparent ability to kill you or a third party, or to cause you or a third party great bodily harm?</p>	<p>Ability or Apparent Ability</p> <p>Does the violator possess the ability or the apparent ability to resist you or a third party, or to cause you or a third party bodily harm?</p>
<p>Opportunity</p> <p>Does the violator have the opportunity to kill you or a third party, or to cause you or a third party great bodily harm?</p>	<p>Opportunity</p> <p>Does the violator have the opportunity to resist you or a third party, or to cause you or a third party bodily harm?</p>
<p>Imminent Jeopardy</p> <p>Has the violator placed you or a third party in imminent danger?</p>	<p>Jeopardy</p> <p>Has the violator placed you or a third party in danger? Jeopardy can be defined as a hazard, danger, or peril.</p>
